Why Greencities?

In Europe there are many networks in Europe dealing with «clean» topics. Why GreenCities can be different?

- ☐ GreenCities will work on cooperation, not on competition
- ☐ GreenCities is a project-oriented network, which focus on cities to achieve integrated approaches to mobility in Europe
- ☐ GreenCities aim to be a meeting point for shared ideas, competences, technologies, requirements, companies, users, institution, research: all inside the «cities arena».

GreenCities aims not to be «different», but to «integrate» all existings under common activities!



Objectives



- Share ideas and new concepts for e-mobility in Europe;
- Integrate e-mobility infrastructures of all European cities;
- Construct an open platform for data (users, vehicles, logistic,..) interchange in Europe;
- Start common projects with other cities;
- Share technical solution with companies;
- Evaluate the actual environmental impact of several proposed strategies;
- Give guidelines to companies for standards and technology integration;
- Promote the “full-green” approach for eMobility: clean energy for electric vehicles.
