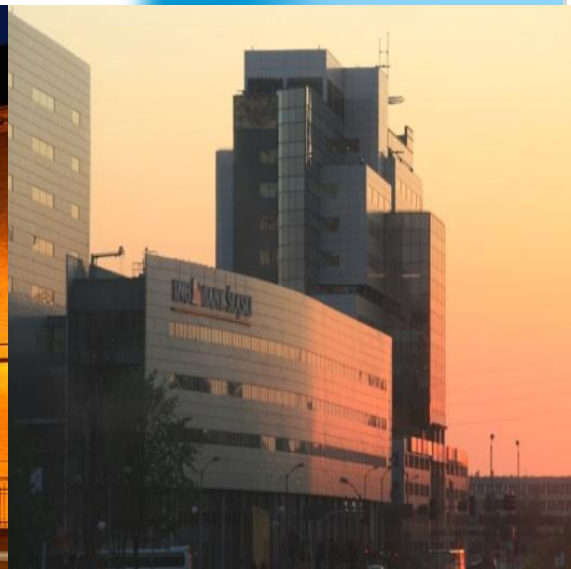

OBJECTIVES OF EVUE PROJECT

MAIN

Reduction of pollution by use of electric vehicles and awareness-raising campaign among citizens about pollution reduction

DETAILED:

- reduction of negative climatic changes

- implementation of the mechanisms in the agglomeration

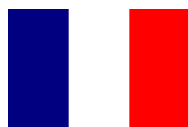
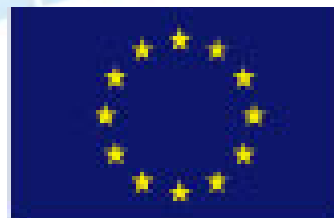
