Electric and hydrogen transport

Denmark:

Free of registration fee until 2015

Copenhagen:

Free parking on all public parking spaces.
Reserved parking at charging points
Free charging – so far!
Electric car sharing





COPENHAGEN TOGETHER

E-Mobility: Electric & Hydrogen cars in the City Administration

By 2010 we had:

- 8 hydrogen & 25 electric hybrid cars
- 1 hydrogen station

In 2012, we will:

- Start-up: Regional Hydrogen and fuel cell partnership. Develop existing and new partnerships, e.g. regional Triplehelix
- Acquire 5-10 of the next-generation hydrogen car
- Up-grade hydrogen station (700 bar)
- Buy 200 electric vehicles

In 2015 we will:

 85 % of all public cars in City of Copenhagen will be EV's







2010 All new cars bought by the municipality will be electrical or hydrogen-powered

2015 85% of the municipality's cars will be electrical or hydrogen-powered
